

# Fairlie Golf Club Local Rules

## Short Version



Last updated September, 2019

### A - Defining Boundaries

All penalty areas are **RED** and are defined by spray lines and / or red stakes.

Out of Bounds is defined by all perimeter fences. The boundary on #10 is defined by white stakes.

### B - Provisional Ball for Ball in a Penalty Area

If a player does not know whether his or her ball is in a penalty area, the player may play a provisional ball using any of the following relief options: stroke-and-distance, back-on-the-line or, the lateral relief option (see Rule 17.1d). ### C - Prohibiting Play From Fringe of Wrong Green

When taking wrong green relief, the wrong green is defined to include the area of the fringe. See *'Full version'* document for full details of this Local Rule.

### D – Preferred Lies (placings) – Refer to the outside board for whether this rule is in place

### E – Protection of Young Trees

The young trees identified by white pegs are no play zones:

- If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 16.1f.

## F – Defining Abnormal Course Conditions (including Immovable Obstructions) (Rule 16)

- Ground under repair is defined by any area encircled by a white line and/or marked with a GUR sign.
- The protective fence behind #6 tee is an immovable obstruction.
- The rock wall and shingle path alongside #6 tee are immovable obstructions.

## G – Animal Holes

Rule 16.1 is modified in this way: Interference does not exist if rabbit scratchings only interfere with the player's stance.

## H – Animal Hoof Damage

Damage that is clearly identifiable as having been caused by animal hoofs is GUR from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.

## I – Bunker Filled with Temporary Water

Flooded bunkers are GUR in the general area. They are not treated as bunkers during the round. See '*Full version*' document for full details of this Local Rule.
